- 4) The remnants of some heavy, easily broken pots are clues that suggest that the Early Woodland people traveled less than in the Archaic Period. ___
- 5) The differences in burial and grave goods suggest that not everyone was equal to everyone else. ___
- 6) According to archaeologists, the different pottery styles of the Middle Woodland Period indicate different levels of importance of different people in the group. ___
- 7) Native Americans in the Late Woodland Period started cultivating corn, beans, and squash because the climate in the Late Woodland Period finally became warm enough for these crops. ___
- 8) Archaeologists found structures made in the shape of a keyhole, which were probably used to smoke meat or as sweathouses. ___
